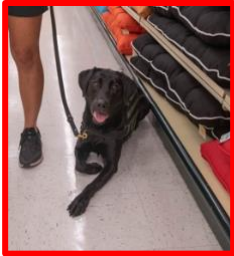
Bunky AHEPA
