

Many American combat Veterans come home from war physically, but mentally they remain on the battlefield. They are imprisoned by their thoughts, crushed by Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD). Suicide is chosen every day by 20+ warriors rather than to live with the devastating effects of PTSD and their invisible battle scars. We now know from validated studies that specially trained Service Dogs can mitigate the horror of PTSD and help overcome the challenges that inhibit these veterans from fully returning to normal life after being at war. These Service Dogs are not "pets". They are **MEDICINE**. They provide treatment for an unseen illness by opening doors both literally and figuratively for the veterans, performing tasks and behaviors that reconnect the veteran with family,

Training Updates


Current training updates there are currently three AHEPA dogs in training: Tommy, Pericles, and Patrick. Our other dogs' places on the wait list have moved up significantly:

Patrick AHEPA


